

TOILETING PLAN

This is the Marblehead Children's Center and Seaside Nursery School's written plan describing procedures for regular toileting, toilet training, and for disposal of or cleaning of soiled clothing, linen, blankets, and diapers. This plan is posted in the toileting and diapering areas.

Marblehead Children's Center and Seaside Nursery School shall toilet train children in accordance with the request of their parents and consistent with the child's physical and emotional abilities.

The following procedures will be implemented:

1. Children will be taken to the bathroom as a group and individually as needed.
2. The children will wait their turn and enter the stalls individually.
3. The children are encouraged to use self-help skills throughout the toileting process. The children are encouraged to ask for help if they need it.
4. The teacher waits outside the stall while the child uses the toilet. The child will be talked through the wiping process if necessary.
5. The child will redress himself with assistance if necessary by the teacher.
6. The child will wash his hands with soap and water and dry them with a paper towel. The towel will be disposed of in the trash barrel by the child.
